GUEST SPEAKER: Rob Lyberg will be our guest speaker on Sunday, November 30 at the evening service.

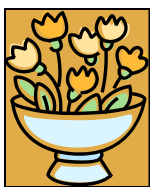
NEW SISTER IN CHRIST: ELAINE DIMTSON was baptized on Sunday evening, November 2. Welcome Elaine.

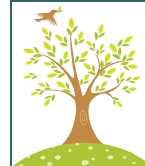
