

THE SALVATION ARMY

- 7. The Salvation Army band is a common sight and sound. "Music plays an important part in Salvation Army religious work...it is symbolic of the cheerful quality of Salvation Army religion" (What is the Salvation Army? P. 25).
- 8. The Army uses women preachers in its teaching system. Catherine Booth (the founder's wife) was a woman preacher who addressed great audiences. She wrote a vigorous defense of the "female ministry."
- 9. The Salvation Army is involved in various enterprises for the raising of money and, according to one of their books, must even "look to the public for some of its financial support" (lbid.,p.26). It also receives federal funds to support its services.

WORD OF GOD

- 7. The use of mechanical instruments of music for Christian worship is not authorized by the New Testament. It is an addition to the specific New Testament command to sing (Eph. 5:19). It was a human introduction of the 7th century A.D.
- 8. The Bible prohibits a woman functioning in such a capacity (1Tim. 2:12ff); she cannot be a public preacher to sexually integrated audiences.
- 9. In the New Testament, the work of the church was supported strictly by free-will contributions from its members (Acts 11:29; 1 Cor. 16:2).
