# Lincoln Park Church of Christ

GUEST SPEAKER

Wissam Al-Ithawi was born in Baghdad, Iraq, to a Sunni Muslim family in 1979. Following the political turmoil in the war-torn country, and the death of his four year old sister in the mid 1990's, he came to a conclusion that Islam is not a right way of life and does not offer any hope, so he became an atheist.

His reading led him to find the Bible in his second year in college in 1997 and through a Catholic friend of his, the realization that the Bible, that promotes values his community has always been in a desperate need for, has never undergone corruption, so he decided to obey the gospel message. It would take him another twelve years to find someone to baptize him into Christ, in a bathtub in a northern-Iraq hotel.

Meeting with some Christians online, he came to the U.S. in April 2011, promptly asked for asylum, and went to a preaching school nine months afterward. He finished school and came to the Detroit area, to take the gospel to the Arab/Muslim population.

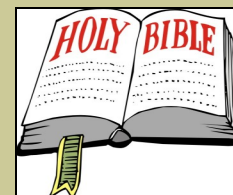
