When one hurts the other four give hugs. When one is rejoicing the other four smile. When there is a struggle we pray for that struggle. And when one is missing the others hunt until that person is found. Don't judge . . . it only happened once. Ayla decided to fall asleep in the basement behind a storage container. I still don't know why. But I do know that the rest of us were determined to keep up the girl hunt for as long as was necessary. Our family is important to us.

Of course, we know that our family is more than just those who live in Riverview. In fact, as a Christian person, I would say that our family is more than just those who are closely related to me. I would encourage every Christian to think the same way. We are all part of a wonderful family! "Both the one who makes men holy and those who are made holy are of the same family. So Jesus is not ashamed to call them brothers" (Hebrews 2:11). This is an amazing family! When JESUS is in your family that is a win. When Jesus is proud to call you family that's even better. And it's true - if you are faithfully a part of the church. Jesus says "whoever does the will of my Father in heaven is my brother and sister and mother" (Matthew 12:50).

So then, I think that changes the way we think about the people in church. The people in the pews around you are your family. We should do the same things for them that we would do for our children. 
