## BE FIRST TO TAKE YOUR GOOD ADVICE

My son, pay attention to my wisdom, turn your ear to my words of insight, that you may maintain discretion and your lips may preserve knowledge. For the lips of the adulterous woman drip honey, and her speech is smoother than oil;

Keep to a path far from her, do not go near the door of her house, lest you lose your honor to others and your dignity to one who is cruel.

Proverbs 5:1-3, 8-9

It doesn't take a leader very long to realize that it's easier to give good advice than to follow it. Solomon proves the point. He tells us repeatedly and with great conviction that only fools fall into adultery. Solomon knew very well the spiritual issues at stake in marriage, for he declares, "The way of man is before the eyes of the Lord, and He ponders all his paths." Proverbs 5:21

And yet somehow, this same leader failed to heed God's explicit warning against kings taking many wives (Deuteronomy 17:17). Solomon blatantly disobeyed this command and married seven hundred women. The result? "His wives turned his heart after other gods and his heart was not loyal to the Lord his God." (1 Kings 11:4). Wise leaders not only give good advice; they heed it. How different the fortunes of Israel might have turned out if Solomon acted on the wisdom he so forcefully expressed to others.

My Dad would always start out with this statement before giving any advice to me or anyone else, "You know what they say about advice, it's free. So take it for what it's worth." Our richest blessings come from being a child of God. He loves us, forgives us, and offers grace to us as we live for him and do our best to obey all His commands. A bit of advice I have learned about giving advice: I ask myself, "Can I live to the same standard that I am telling someone else to do?"
