Remember and Apply

Reading the Bible as a Christian requires two main steps: interpretation and application. The first part is determining what the text means. What did the author mean when he wrote to the ancient readers? The next step is applying this text to figure out what God is saying to us. (Yes, this is me sharing something my graduate class is going over this week - it's only fair: if I have to learn it you should too.) We read, we study, we remember, we apply. That's what the Bible says to do. "But the man who looks intently into the perfect law that gives freedom, and continues to do this, not forgetting what he has heard, but doing it - he will be blessed in what he does" (James 1:25).

My goal as a teaching minister is to lead people into this blessing. You're doing more than many if you make it your habit to read the Bible. And I encourage that. You're doing even better if you're one of the few who strive to work hard to study and understand what the Bible says. Please do! But stopping at this step will not lead to blessing. You can study all day but your desire must be to live by what you read! The Bible speaks to all the major arenas of our lives. Are you standing under its authority? Are you applying the text to you? I pray that you do.

To help let me ask the church, in what areas of your life do you need encouragement? What verses do you need to put into your heart? I asked my class what verse I should encourage you to know and some goober gave me a verse about cows and idolatry and drinking. So instead I'll ask you - what will help you on the road to being blessed by God? What verse do you need to remember, so that you are encouraged to apply it in your life? What verses do we need encouragement to apply as a church? Please text your suggestions to my cell-phone. Let's encourage one another in the study and application of God's Word. I want us to be blessed.


