The Church at Jerusalem should serve as a model for every church. The Church at Jerusalem serves as a model for every church on what God expects His churches to look like. The Church at Jerusalem was not seeking after greatness, but she attained it because each member did what God called them to do.

In the Bible we see two extremes: the Church at Jerusalem and the Church at Corinth. The Church at Jerusalem did things right while the Church at Corinth did things wrong. Inside the Church at Corinth there was contention, carnality, and corruption. The Church at Jerusalem was very different: everybody was involved and interested. Members gave, prayed, witnessed, and worked.

Today, may we make the Church at Jerusalem our pattern and be that kind of Church. In our verses today we are going to behold what the first church looked like at beginning. I want you to see how our text defines what it is that makes a church a great church. There are a few defining characteristics, or marks, or essentials of the church that this passage lays bare. So let's go back through the passage and identify the marks of a great church.

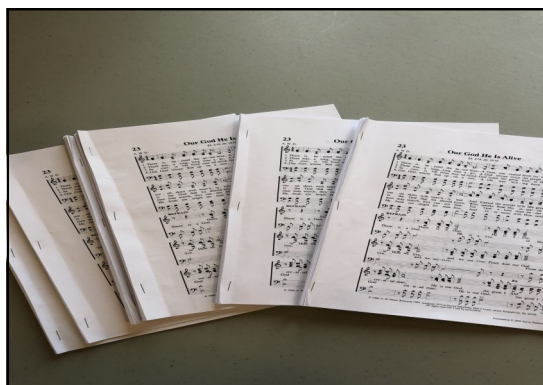

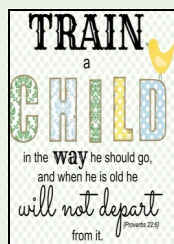

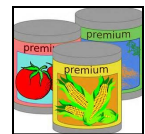
